## Female Dress Code

-A smart top suitable for a work place environment (with no large graphics or logos); it is not acceptable to wear a low cut t-shirt or vest top under an open blouse or shirt

-Suit or tailored jacket (optional)

-A plain jumper or cardigan (no large graphics or logos) is optional (hoodies and sports tops are not allowed)

-Skirts must be reasonable length – no shorter than just above the knee

-Smart business style trousers (no leggings or jeans of any kind or colour)

-Dresses must be reasonable length – no shorter than just above the knee, it is not acceptable for this to be low cut

-Smart business style shoes – (trainers, plimsolls and canvas shoes are not permitted)

-Outdoor coats, hats and scarves are not to be worn inside the Academy buildings

-Hair should be of a natural colour (no blues, pinks, greens, etc.) with no extremes of style

**Students are expected to adopt a professional approach to their sixth form studies and the dress code reflects this.**

**Failure to comply with the dress code could result in students being sent home to change.**

**All students must wear their ID badge at all times.**

**Football Academy match day tracksuit may be worn on training and match days only.**

**The Academy reserves the right to decide what is considered appropriate.**

## Male Dress Code

-Formal collared shirt (with no large graphics or logos and a tie is optional)

-Suit or tailored jacket (optional)

-A plain jumper or cardigan (no large graphics or logos) is optional (hoodies and sports tops are not allowed)

-Smart business style trousers (jeans of any colour, cords, chinos are not allowed)

-Smart business style shoes – (trainers, plimsolls and canvas shoes are not permitted)

-Hair should only be of a natural colour (no blues, pinks, greens, etc.) with no extremes of style

## Not allowed:

- **No** vest tops, leggings or jeggings
- **No** denim, leather or jeans
- **No** sandals, flip-flops or any shoes with an open toe, open back or decorative accessories
- **No** trainers
- **No** canvas shoes or plimsolls
- **No** knee high boots and heels should be appropriate for a work place environment
- **No** visible facial piercings, except one pair of earrings
- **No** visible tattoos
